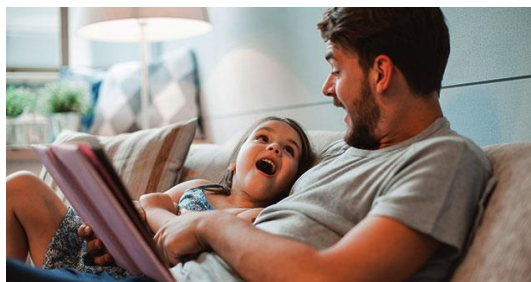


Beacon View Primary Reading Pledge



Reading is a vital part of a child's education as without being able to read at a good standard, children will struggle to access almost every other subject within school. Reading can also open a mind to different worlds and allow readers to visit different places in their dreams.

At Beacon View Primary Academy, we aim for all our children to start their secondary school being able to read at age expectation and to have developed a love of reading. To achieve this we believe that there has to be a strong partnership and commitment between the school, parents and child.

This reading pledge outlines each of our roles.

As a school, we will ensure that every child:

- Has the opportunity to enhance their reading skills within daily whole-class reading sessions;
- Will have access to a range of books to read for enjoyment;
- Will be able to take home an appropriate reading book each day;
- Has access to the school's library or the local public library each term;
- Has the opportunity to use Bug Club online every week.

As a parent, we will ensure our child will:

- Read at home at least three times a week;
- Bring their reading book into school each day;
- Bring in their Reading Record each day signed by someone at home;
- Be encouraged to read a variety of text e.g. signs, newspapers, cereal boxes etc.

As a child, I will:

- Bring in my reading book and Reading Record every day;
- Take home my reading book every day;
- Read at home at least 3 times a week.
