We have got lots of activities planned whether your child is in school or working at home.

1. 'Bed time' Storytelling session

We are asking all children to wear their pyjamas to school as we are going to be doing 'bedtime storytelling' sessions in class in the afternoon. Children will be given hot chocolate and will get comfy as their teacher reads them a special story or two. Children may also suggest their favourite book that they would like to be read. Children at home can also keep their pyjamas on for the day and join in with the storytelling sessions.

2. Design a reading display in your window competition

This will then be emailed on to the next class, who will write the next part before passing it on and so on. We hope that we will then be able to share the finished story with you all!
