

Beacon View Primary Sport Premium Funding 2017-2018

This additional funding has been made available directly to schools to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport for all children. Schools have the freedom to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport and in turn enhance participation level and attainment.

At Beacon View we have been allocated approximately £18,930 for the academic year 2017-2018. This money will be used to enhance and broaden our PE provision, making it exciting for all children and encouraging lifelong participation in sport and physical activity.

Aims for funding:

- To encourage healthy lifestyles and lifelong participation in sport and physical activity.
- To enhance the quality of PE teaching for both the children and teachers
- To improve opportunities to take part in inter school festivals and competitions
- To develop self-esteem in all children enabling them to become motivated, independent learners.
