Online Learning: An Introduction

Welcome to online home learning for pupils in Years 1 and 2 at Beacon View Primary Academy. Now that many of our pupils are isolating and we are abiding by the Government's requests to stay at home, we have looked at how we can continue to support your child with not only their academic learning, but their social and emotional development at this time.

For pupils in Years 1 and 2, the weekly activities will be put together into a Sway (just like a website) and published on the school website. For any children who do not have access to the online materials, alternative provision will be provided in the form of paper packs that you can collect from the school once a week. Further details about these will come out soon to those families who have told us their children cannot access the internet at home.

We hope that by taking this personalised approach to your child's learning, we will continue to support them in being the best that they can be.

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Online Learning: In Summary

Where can my child access their home learning activities?

By visiting the Home Learning section of the school website.

When will they be available?

All resources for the week will be on the school website each Monday morning.

Any answers will be added to the same 'Sway' on a Friday.

What are the expectations?

We understand that this is a difficult time in households and children may be feeling unsettled.

One way to ease this will be to set a clear routine and expectations for your children. However - and this is really important - we do not expect there to be a battle over learning! If your child is tired, or needs his/her emotional needs met one day, then maybe look at the more creative learning ideas and come back to the writing and maths the following day.

Every week, we ask you to support your child to complete:

3-5 writing/reading comprehension activities

3-5 maths activities

Daily phonics (This will be on a separate sway and information will be sent about what phase your child is working within)

Every Monday, a new 'sway' for the week will be added to the website.

You simply need to click on the link and it will take you to a page of activities.

Some of the activities will be interactive, which you can complete on a phone, tablet or computer.

Other activities will require paper to work on or, if available, you could print out the pages.

Completing and Submitting Work

It is not expected for your child to send their work to their teacher, however the teachers are more than happy to answer any questions and support your child's learning where they can. Work will not be marked. However, where possible, answers will be shared to allow your child to self assess their own learning and use the reflective skills we've developed in class.

Option 1: Completing Offline

Option 2: Completing and Submitting by Email

- ✓ Children can send their answers by writing an email to their class teacher
