We know that some children will be lucky enough to get phones and phone linked watches for Christmas this year. Smart watches that link to phones should not be worn to school. Whilst many of these have a school mode, these do not stop the child from using them to make calls or send messages so even with these settings they are still not able to wear these to school. All classrooms in the school have a working clock at the front of the room so that children can see the time.

The children should be arriving at or after this time, especially if they have permission to travel to school on their own as there is no one to supervise them prior to the school doors opening at 08.38 am.
