


Beacon View Primary News





Wow another busy week. A huge well done to all of the children who auditioned for BV's got talent, they were all so confident and should be proud of themselves.

We are looking forward to welcoming you all on Friday for the official opening ceremony for the playground. Parents/ carers are able to join us, using the Allaway Avenue entrance from 2.15 pm, with the ceremony starting at 2.30 pm. There will be spaces on the playground and down the winding path for you to watch the ceremony which will be approximately 30 mins. After the ceremony the children will return to classes and you will be able to collect them as normal at 3.15 pm. The school summer fayre will then begin at 3.20 pm with stalls on the field. To enable us to celebrate together we will also be issuing families with a hot food ticket, for one item either a burger or a sausage (or vegetarian options).

Contact Sheets and OFSTED questionnaire

Over the next fortnight, you will receive two important documents:

- 1. A copy of your child's details from Arbor
- 2. A copy of the OFSTED Parent Questionnaire

We are asking all families to review and return both documents. Every set of returned papers will be entered into a prize draw to win a £20 Love to Shop voucher.

When OFSTED visit, they will send out an electronic questionnaire to parents/carers, which must be completed within 24 hours. To ensure everyone has a chance to share their views, we are also sending out the same questions on paper and will accept completed paper copies. These will be shared with OFSTED as part of our feedback.

Even if you update your child's details using the Arbor app, **please still return the paper form** so that your entry can be included in the prize draw. You can update your child's details at any time using the **Arbor app**.

It's really important to us that OFSTED hears from as many of you as possible. We would love to receive a response from every family. I personally read every questionnaire. If you include your name, I will respond directly; otherwise, your feedback remains completely anonymous. (We use the returned contact sheet—separated on arrival—to select a prize draw winner.)

Year 6 attending Castle View on the 23rd June for - Being Politely Rebellious: The Power of Independent Thinking and Positive Networks



In a world that often encourages us to follow the crowd, learning to think independently is a powerful skill, especially when done with kindness and respect. This session, *Being Politely Rebellious – The Power of Networks*, invites Year 6 pupils to explore what it means to make thoughtful choices, even when those choices go against the grain. It's about understanding that you can stand up for what you believe in without being unkind or disrespectful. Children will be encouraged to reflect on their values, question ideas in a constructive way, and recognise the strength in choosing their own path. At the same time, they'll learn how to build and rely on positive networks; friends, family, and communities that support them in being their best selves. Through discussion, activities, and real-life examples, pupils will see how respectful rebellion can lead to positive change, both in their own lives and in the wider

world. This session aims to empower young people to be brave, thoughtful, and connected, ready to step into secondary school with confidence in who they are and what they stand for.
