

FREE SCHOOL MEALS - IMPORTANT UPDATE

From 1 April 2018 children entitled to benefits related Free School Meals (FSM) at any time remain entitled until they finish either primary or secondary education. This continues even if the family finances improve.



From **1** April **2025** entitlement to FSM will end **if** income increases above £7,400 annual net income over a three-month period (for example more than £1850 net income in the last three Universal Credit assessment periods).

Are you entitled?

Our school offers a free lunchtime meal to all children in Years R, 1, and 2, regardless of their parent's or carer's income. To ensure we receive our full Pupil Premium funding and to maintain eligibility for free meals once children move to Year 3, we ask that all parents and carers of Key Stage 1 children complete the free school meal application form.

Example:

- Amar is in reception. Her mum registers her for free school meals in March 2025. Amar continues to be entitled to FSM until she finishes primary education. Changes in family income don't matter.
- Ben is also in reception and is entitled to FSM but is not registered until April 2025. If the family income
 goes above £7400 net per annum (£616.67 per month) FSM will end and will need to be reclaimed if
 income goes down again.

Free School Meals are worth £674.50 per child, per school year. Eligible children may also receive other support, such as <u>free holiday programmes</u> and <u>supermarket vouchers</u>, when these are available.

Claiming free school meals also helps our school to get additional funding for each pupil registered.
